<b>Ingredients:</b>	Dimethyl benzyl ammonium chloride 4.5%, dimethyl ethyl benzyl ammonium chloride 4.5%.		
<b>Indications:</b>	Broad spectrum action against Gram-ve and Gram+ve organisms. Cleans and disinfects all surfaces, equipment and veterinary instruments. Suitable for hygiene control for livestock bedding, rearing pens and around stables.		
<b>Action</b>	Formulated to have disinfectant activity against a wide range of micro-organisms in the presence of organic matter. Advanced formulation that remains stable when mixed. Vetacide also controls micro-organisms that cause odours.		
<b>Administration:</b>	Can be mixed in cold, warm, soft or hard water without effecting efficacy. Livestock and feed troughs do not have to be removed from the pen while applying Vetacide. If removing feed troughs for a more thorough clean rinse out with water afterwards.		
<b>Dosage:</b>	10mL per 4L of water or 25mL per 4L for Tb control.		
<b>Special Precautions:</b>	Avoid contact with eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid contact of undiluted substance on skin.		
<b>Storage:</b>	Do not store in direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.		
<b>Environmental Status:</b>	Vetacide is biodegradable and poses little risk to the environment leaving no residues. Safe to use in septic tanks.		
<b>First Aid:</b>	If swallowed: DO NOT induce vomiting, contact a doctor or the National Poisons Centre (0800 POISON or 0800 764 766) immediately. If skin contact with undiluted product occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly for at least 1 minute.		
<b>Registration:</b>	Registered number 641672 Class 5: pharmaceutical, veterinary and sanitary preparations, plasters, materials for dressing, disinfectants, fungicides and herbicides. Registered number 641671 Class 3: cleaning, polishing, scouring and abrasive preparations, bleaching preparations and other substances for laundry use.		
<b>Other:</b>	When mixed at the recommended mixing rate Vetacide is non-corrosive and will not cause corrosion on pipe frames, kennels, netting or welded joints, plastic, rubber or stainless steel.
