Also known as:

- Grass Staggers
- Grass Tetany
- Deficiency of Magnesium in the bloodstream

Hypomagnesemia is a disorder associated with low levels of magnesium in the blood and cerebrospinal fluid around the brain. The cause is complex, involving animal, nutritional, climatic and management factors.

HYPOMAGNESEMIA

Etiology:

- Decreased Magnesium intake
- Onset of lactation
- Increase in ruminal Ammonia

Symptoms:

- Nervousness
- Exaggerated response to stimuli
- Stiffness and muscle twitching
- Convulsions
- Paresis and collapse
