When to dose?

- 1. Establish a dosing programme with your veterinary surgeon.
- 2. It is recommended dosing programmes commence in the early autumn (February to May) period and again August/September.
- 3. It is also recommended to dose the cattle prior to entering feedlots or housing.
- The interval between doses will depend on the level of pasture contamination, weather conditions and geographical location.

Dosage

Consult your veterinary surgeon to establish a dosing schedule. Know the weight of the animal before administering.

Withholding cattle and bobby calves: 28 days. Milk 14 days.
