Important Instructions

ALWAYS • Wear gloves • Use a clean, dry container when making CREDENCE solutions • Ensure that tablets are completely dissolved before closing the solution container
• Allow 30 minutes from tablet addition before using solution

AVOID • Use with animal fibres such as silk and wool • Mixing with acids and strong reducing agents • Mixing with vaccines, antibiotics, vitamins and other readily oxidisable materials

APPROVED USES AND DILUTION RATES:

This disinfectant product has been approved for disinfection of inanimate surfaces where an approved product is required to be used under the control legislation for the following specific disease(s) orders;

- Foot and mouth disease at the dilution rate of one part this preparation plus 299 parts of water;
- Swine vesicular disease at the dilution rate of one part this preparation plus 299 parts of water;
- Poultry diseases including avian influenza, influenza of avian origin in mammals, Newcastle disease, parvovirus at a dilution rate of one part of this preparation plus 449 parts of water.

This disinfectant product has also been approved at a dilution of 1 part of this preparation plus 299 parts water for disinfection of inanimate surfaces where General Orders require the use of an approved disinfectant, but this approval does not apply to disinfection required under the specific control legislation relating to Tuberculosis disease. This approval is granted under the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Orders made by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in England, Scottish ministers in Scotland and Welsh ministers in Wales. The contents of this container are guaranteed by the manufacturer to be of the same composition and quality as the sample submitted for approval testing.

Please note:

Dilution rates for disinfectants for use against Foot and Mouth Disease and Swine Vesicular Disease relate to effectiveness when applied to a clean surface

- (a) thoroughly washed or sprayed with an approved disinfectant
(b) thoroughly cleansed, ensuring the dung, litter, etc. is removed and disposed of so there is no risk of contact with livestock; and
(c) (the clean area) washed or sprayed with an approved disinfectant used at the approved dilution rate
