ACVM CLASS DETERMINATION ADVICE

Credence Stock Wash

The Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines team has completed a class determination for the above named products based on the information provided by the applicant.

Determination

This product is not defined as an agricultural compound under the Agricultural Compound and Veterinary Medicines (ACVM) Act 1997.

This product does not require registration under the ACVM Act to be imported, marketed, distributed, sold or used in New Zealand.

Rationale

This product is intended for use as a sanitising animal wash prior to slaughter. The intended purpose is to control human health pathogens (i.e. food safety) and not for the management of the animal. Therefore, the product does not meet the definition of an agricultural compound under the ACVM Act.

Advice

This class determination becomes invalid if:

- 1. This product is changed in any way.
- 2. This product is advertised using information different from that provided in the process of this class determination.
