- Stomach Hair Worm
- Black Scour Worm

Where treatment is required, a broad-spectrum drench is recommended.

COMMON SHEEP WORMS AND SUITABLE DRENCH OPTIONS

Drench selection should be based on faecal egg count (FEC) results, seasonal worm challenge, and known resistance status on your farm.

Small Intestinal Worm	Combination Sheep Drench	Albendazole + Levamisole Dual Combination	Autumn
Black Scour Worm	Paralock Triple + Tape	Abamectin + Albendazole + Levamisole.	Winter
Thin Necked Intestinal Worm	Gold Drench	Levamisole, single active	Winter
Broad, Nasal Bot, Itch Mite, Adult Liver Fluke	Moxisure LA or Paralock Triple	Moxidectin Abamectin + Albendazole + Levamisole.	All Seasons

Scanning Season – Choose Fadeaway

When it comes to sheep marking, Fadeaway continues to be the marker of choice for farmers who care about wool quality and pelt value.

Fadeaway has been extensively tested and proven not to stain wool or pelts. Unlike traditional markers, Fadeaway sits on top of the wool fibre rather than penetrating it, helping protect fleece quality while still providing excellent visibility.

Fadeaway markings can last up to three months, even during periods of high rainfall. While the colour may fade slightly faster than some traditional markers, the trade-off is clear: Cleaner wool, Better wool returns, and No staining.

Colour performance from longest-lasting to shortest-lasting: • Purple • Pink • Blue • Orange • Green • Yellow* *Yellow naturally blends more with wool colour and may appear to fade sooner.
